- c. Michael Drive Parking – Red Curb
ACTION: PW to install red curb between Resident and Perc Lot driveways. “NO PARKING” sign to be placed on Perc Lot fencing.

- d. E&TS Resolution – 2nd Avenue between Divarty & 8th Street (continued from 05042021 meeting)
ACTION: PD follow-up w/ Enforcement of new speed limit. Review college academic schedule (Late-July) for increased enforcement period.

- e. Robin Drive – Speeding (continued from 05042021 meeting)
ACTION: PW to perform speed survey (tubes) on Robin Dr. to analyze speeds, vehicles, times for speeding. Bring Item back for discussion.
