**ACTION: PW to conduct speed survey for corridor at key locations & meet with Developer Engineer regarding possible crossings if viable.**
- b. Marina Heights Drive, Bluffs & California Ave – Speeding, Stop Signs & Crosswalk  
**ACTION: PW to conduct speed survey for corridor at key locations & meet with Developer Engineer regarding possible crossings if viable.**
- c. Reservation Road – Restricted Parking Signs (Cmdr. Anderson)  
**ACTION: PD to coordinate with PW regarding wording & placement for signage restricting parking hours for commercial vehicles**

- d. Reservation to Del Monte South – Far right turn lane  
**ACTION: PW to refresh bots dots (or alternatively lane-line extension striping) at intersection.**
- e. Imjin Parkway Issues (Crosswalk)  
**ACTION: PW has conducted a Safety Corridor Study regarding pedestrian crossings & are awaiting Council action/funding for improvement projects.**
- f. Intersection of Imjin & Reservation Road  
**ACTION: PD to evaluate conditions during hours of concern. No Further Action required.**
