The City of Marina has thoroughly reviewed the application materials that you provided for your Commercial Cannabis Business License Application to operate at 3170 Del Monte Blvd, Marina Ca. 93933. The application has been deemed incomplete. You have one additional opportunity to provide the listed items by Wednesday, August 8, 2019, at 5 pm. You must resubmit two hard copies of the materials and one electronic copy.

- 1. Proof of prior successful business operations at a similar scale of annual revenue, for at least two years, in the form of a financial statement or like kind.
- 2. The application included Limitations on City's Liability waivers, Live Scans and Background documentation for Brian Mitchell and Jose Pecho, however, per the Statement of Information on the California Secretary of State website, Tony Huang is the Secretary for the Shryne Group, Inc and the application failed to include any documents for him as well as the several Shryne Group members (James Kim and John Avidor, etc.) listed who are not involved in the day-to-day operations, however, are part of the "Supporting Team". The hard deadline for submitting Live Scan applications to the City was May 24, 2019, for all owners and principal employees. Moreover, all owners and principal employees were to be disclosed with Background documentation at the time of the application submittal deadline of June 7, 2019. Please provide documentation that demonstrates the status of the ownership membership structure of your corporation as of June 7, 2019, and provide an explanation as why the individuals noted above where not disclosed through Live Scan and Background documentation.
