The City of Marina is forming a General Plan Advisory Committee (GPAC) of 11-13 community representatives to collaborate and provide guidance throughout the General Plan Update process. ***It is critical that each person appointed to the GPAC be willing to bring great ideas to the group while being able to listen respectfully to others. Members will be expected to stay with the GPAC for the duration of the planning process, which is anticipated to last through December 2024*** and will include 8-10 GPAC meetings. GPAC members receive no payment for their work.

Prospective GPAC members should be aware of the following criteria which will be used in evaluating candidates. A GPAC member must:

1. Be a City of Marina resident or property/business owner within the City of Marina.
2. Commit the time that is necessary to carry out the duties of a GPAC member. This includes time to learn about and stay abreast of General Plan issues, to attend committee meetings, and perform committee assignments.
3. Be genuinely interested in General Plan related matters and understand the importance of a General Plan to reflect and advance the needs of the community. ***This is an exciting time for the City of Marina!***
4. Understand the local community, its social and cultural needs, and be willing to communicate those needs to the committee.
5. Be able to work with others to reach a common goal.
6. Be open-minded, intellectually curious, and respectful of the opinions of others in the development of recommendations to the City Council.
7. File a Form 700 Conflict of Interest

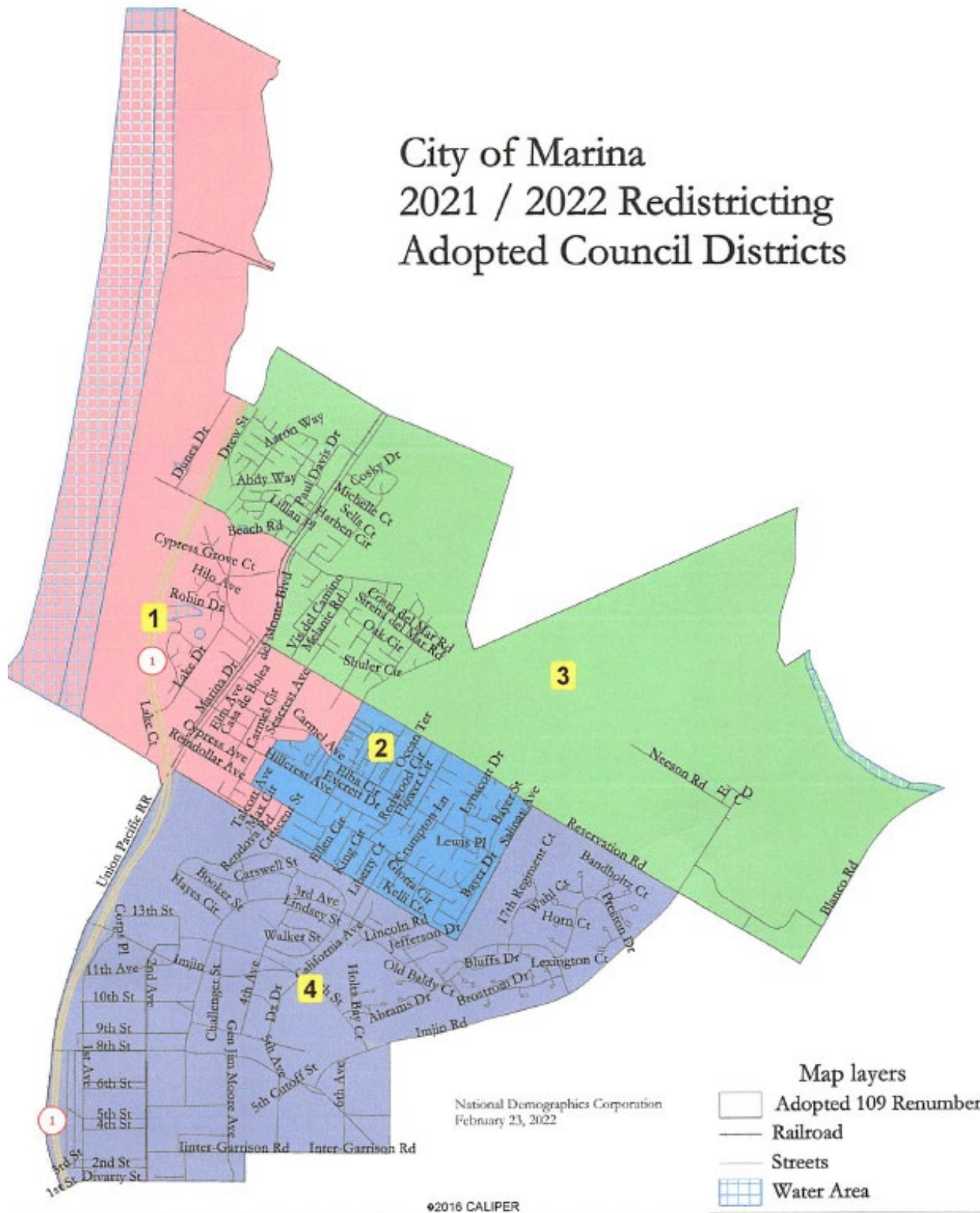
