## SIDEWALK VENDOR STANDARDS AND AGREEMENT

Sidewalk Vendor as defined in § 10.46.020 of the Marina Municipal Code: Sidewalk vendor means a person who sells food or merchandise from a pushcart, stand, display, pedal-driven cart, wagon, showcase, rack, or other nonmotorized conveyance, or from one's person, upon a public sidewalk or other pedestrian path, as defined in California Government Code Section 51036.

cor	lewalk vendor shall comply with <u>Chapter 8.50</u> , prohibiting the use of polystyrene foam ntainers, and requiring that to-go containers are made from biodegradable, compostable or cyclable products.	
	dewalk vendor shall comply with Chapter 8.60, which prohibits the use of single-use plastic ryout bags. All carryout shall be done using recycled paper bags or reusable carryout bags.	
p.n	dewalk vendors shall only operate in residential zones between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 n. and only operate in commercial, industrial, airport, or open space zones between the hours of 00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.
