The City of Marina is seeking community input on how to allocate \$3 million in potential payments for recreational and public improvements in the City's coastal zone. These funds would become available to the City if the California American Water Company desalination project is ever built.

Your feedback is crucial to shaping the priorities for these potential funds. The City is conducting its own independent outreach and engagement effort to hear directly from Marina residents. All input will be compiled into a formal report that the Marina City Council will submit to the California Coastal Commission in April.
