## NUMEROUS VEHICLES WERE BURGLARIZED IN MARINA AND MONTEREY – TWO ADULTS ARRESTED

On August 21, 2010 at 0710 hours, an off duty Marina Officer noticed two adult males that he believed were lingering for the purpose of committing a crime. When the two adult males were contacted, they were identified as Jerry Franklin and James Williams. Williams was found to be in possession of numerous electronic items and Marijuana.

After further investigation, Franklin and Williams were arrested.

Between 0700 and 1600 hours, the city of Marina and Monterey combined conducted over eight burglary investigations. At the beginning stages of our burglary investigations, no suspects were identified.

Later in the day, Monterey Police advised that one of there burglary victims was missing a GPS device. When Williams was arrested by the Marina Police Department, he was in possession of the stolen GPS device from the city of Monterey. Further investigation will be ongoing to determine if they were involved in any other burglaries.

Jerry Mark Franklin, 21 years old, was booked into the Monterey County Jail for Prowling and Violation Probation.

James Ellis Williams, 19 years old, was booked into the Monterey County Jail for Prowling, Providing False Identification to Police, and for Possession of Stolen Property.
