Two Arrested for Burglary of the City of Marina Teen Center & Community Center

On January 20, 2011, about 12:25 AM, the Marina Police Department was dispatched to 304 Hillcrest Avenue on a report of a burglary at the City of Marina Teen Center located at 304 Hillcrest Avenue. At 8:20 AM the Police Department was dispatched to another burglary, this time at the City of Marina Community Center located at 211 Hillcrest Avenue. In cases TVs, computers, computer equipment, video games and video game components were stolen. The estimated cash value of the items taken is \$1,000.

An extensive investigation ensued wherein Marina officers began evaluating evidence and leads and due to their diligence two suspects were identified, an adult male and a juvenile male. The suspects were arrested for two counts of burglary, two counts of possession of stolen property and one count each of conspiracy. The juvenile suspect was also charged with violation of probation. The stolen property was recovered.

Arrested was Raymond Enriquez, 18 years old, of Marina who was booked into Monterey County Jail and a 14 year old male juvenile from Seaside who was booked into Monterey County Juvenile Hall.
