On Friday, May 20, 2011 about 1300 hours, Marina Police officers were in the area of Carmel Avenue and Seacrest Avenue when one of the officers spotted a 16 year old male juvenile that was wanted for probation violation and being a runaway juvenile. The officer turned around to make contact and the juvenile had fled the area with two other male juveniles.

Marina officers made an area check and spotted the wanted juvenile and two other male juveniles, ages 15 and 17 years old, in the area of the 200 block of Mortimer Lane. When officers attempted to contact the three juveniles, they all fled on foot. Additional Marina Police officers and detectives responded and set up a perimeter around the area. The officers were able to take all three of the suspects into custody after a short period of time.

Subsequent to their arrest, the suspects were found to be in possession of marijuana and cocaine in packaging indicative of drug sales. All three suspects were booked into the Monterey County Juvenile Hall for various charges, including resisting arrest, violation of probation, and possession of controlled substances for sale.
