LOADED FIREARM DISCOVERED IN A VEHICLE

On June 19, 2011, approximately 02:48 hours, a traffic stop was conducted on a vehicle after a Marina Officer observed that the vehicle failed to stop at more than one intersection.

The driver was arrested after he was found to be under the influence of an alcoholic beverage. During a search of the vehicle a loaded firearm was located. Two passengers that were in the rear seat of the vehicle were also arrested.

Jesus Ramirez-Rocha (19 years old) was arrested for Driving under the influence of an alcoholic beverage (DUI), and for possession of a Concealed and Loaded Firearm.

Bernardo Medina-Garcia (23 years old) and Esther Espinoza (18 years old) were both arrested for Possession of a Concealed and Loaded Firearm.

All three were booked into the Monterey County Jail.
