WOMAN ARRESTED FOR COMMERCIAL BURGLARY AND POSSESSION OF NARCOTICS

On September 16, 2011, at 2141 hours, Marina Police Officers responded to the Dunes Shopping Center, located on 100 block of General Stillwell Drive, in regards to a commercial burglary.

Amy Huntington (42), of Pacific Grove, was detained by store security after she was seen exiting the store with out paying for over \$600 worth of merchandise. Huntington was known to store security due to the fact that she had committed the same offense five other times during the month of September, however eluded arrest.

The store staff estimates that Huntington had taken over \$1,000 worth of merchandise during the five recorded incidents in the Marina store. Huntington was also currently on bail for a narcotics arrest earlier in the year.

After her arrest, Huntington was found to be in possession of over five grams of Methamphetamine, prescription medication which was not prescribed, and hypodermic syringes.

Huntington was booked into the Monterey County Jail on six counts of 459 PC-Burglary, 11377 HS-Possession of a Controlled Substance, 4140 BP-Possession of Hypodermic Syringes, 4060 BP-Unlawful Possession of Prescription Pills, and 12022.1(b) PC-Committing a Felony while on Bail.

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
