MARINA K-9 LOCATES ATTEMPTED ROBBERY SUSPECT

On September 20, 2011, approximately 4:29 P.M., Marina Police Officers were dispatched to the Wells Fargo Bank, 3160 Vista del Camino, on report of a robbery in progress. The suspect stated he had a bomb strapped to his body.

While officers were en route, the suspect fled the bank. A perimeter was established and a search conducted. Multiple items of evidence were located.

Marina K-9 Thunder and his handler, Officer Richard Moreno, located the suspect hiding in a nearby apartment complex in the 3000 block of Eucalyptus.

John White, transient, was arrested and charged with attempted robbery, terrorist threats, false report of a bomb, and violation of parole.
