FEMALE ARRESTED FOR ASSAULT ON OFFICERS

On December 30, 2011, about 12:07 A.M., Marina Officers were dispatched to a report of six females beating a female in the parking lot of an apartment complex.

On officers arrival they contacted several subjects. Jossie Caceres, 18 y.o. of Marina, refused to comply with officer's commands and became physically aggressive. When officers attempted to take her into custody she began fighting violently and grabbed an officer's taser. As the officer took evasive action to prevent his taser from being taken, Caceres bit the officer, resulting in an injury that required medical attention. After she was in custody she continued to resist and injured a second officer. The officer requiring medical attention was treated at the hospital and later released.

Jossie Caceres was booked into Monterey County Jail on charges of Battery on Police Officers, Delaying and Obstructing Police Officers, Attempting to Disarm a Police Officer, Public Intoxication, and an outstanding warrant.
