SUSPECT ARRESTED AFTER FOOT CHASE

On 03/26/12, about 0211 hours, Marina Police Officers contacted two males that were acting suspicious in the area of Reservation Road and Lynscott Drive. During the course of the contact it was determined that one of the men was in possession of narcotics paraphernalia, hypodermic needles, and suspected methamphetamine.

After realizing he was about to be arrested, the suspect took off running from the officers and was pursued on foot. The suspect ran through yards, jumped over fences of residences, and at one point got onto the roof top of a residence as he continued to flee. A perimeter was set up in the area by officers from the Marina Police Department, the CSUMB Police Department and the California Highway Patrol to contain the suspect. He was ultimately captured by officers and taken into custody in the rear yard of a residence in the 400 Block of Edna Court. A Taser was used to subdue the suspect at the time of his arrest.

The suspect was a homeless transient and did not have any identification in his possession. As of this time, he has not been positively identified. He was arrested for possession of a controlled substance, possession of narcotics paraphernalia, possession of hypodermic needles, and resisting arrest. The suspect was booked into Monterey County Jail.

Neither the suspect nor any officers were injured in the incident.
