### MARINA MAN MISSING – CONSIDERED AT RISK

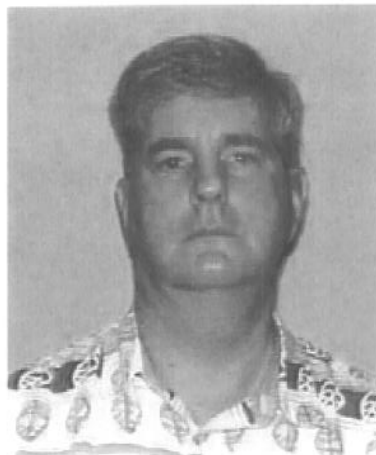

On April 09, 2012, about 3:27 PM, Marina Police Officers were dispatched to a report of a missing, at-risk, male adult, who left his residence around 9:00 AM this morning. He left a suicide note, his last will and testament and a voicemail indicating suicidal tendencies on a family member's telephone.

With the help of OnStar, Deupree's vehicle was located in the City of Santa Clara. It was sold to a local car dealer. Deupree's whereabouts are unknown.

The male is identified as 59-year-old David Deupree. Deupree is diagnosed with severe depression. Deupree is described as having short brown hair, blue eyes, approximately 6'0" tall and weighing about 225 lbs. Family members could not provide a clothing description of what Deupree may be wearing.
