Subject arrested for passing counterfeit \$100 bills in several local businesses.

Marina Police received information from loss prevention officers at the Kohl's Store in Marina regarding a subject passing counterfeit U.S. currency. The subject reportedly also passed additional counterfeit U.S. currency in adjacent counties.

The subject was stopped as she drove away from the business. The subject was positively identified by loss prevention and she was subsequently arrested. Police found additional counterfeit U.S. currency in her possession and evidence to suggest there were several other victims, including surrounding states.

Arrested was Nakisha Rolley, 26, from Oakland, California. Rolley was lodged in the Monterey County Jail on a wide variety of charges, including commercial burglary, possession of burglary tools, and possession of counterfeit money.

The United States Secret Service was contacted. The investigation continues.
